Would you like to be a Host Carer and share your home and your heart with a child with disabilities? A Host Carer is an individual that has been recruited, assessed, trained and vetted by Avista. This person is approved to have the personal qualities and skills to care for a person with a disability on a short-term or long-term basis. Home Sharing is a community based service that provides both short breaks (respite) and full-time (shared living) placements to children and adults with a disability. These breaks take place in the Host Carer's Home. The scheme is voluntary; Training and Support is provided, along with an an allowance which is tax free.
