THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Tomorrow, Monday 8th December is the feast of the Immaculate Conception and is a church holy day. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass will be celebrated here at 10.30am and 5.45pm.

THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

The Immaculate Conception is a Catholic dogma that states that Mary, whose conception was brought about the normal way, was conceived without original sin or its stain. That's what "immaculate" means: without stain. The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is celebrated each year on December 8th.

The essence of original sin consists in the deprivation of sanctifying grace, and its stain is a corrupt nature. Mary was preserved from these defects by God's grace; from the first instant of her existence she was in the state of sanctifying grace and was free from the corrupt nature original sin brings.
