THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Next Tuesday, January 6th, is a church holyday: the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord commemorates the visit of the magi to worship the baby Jesus as told in the Gospel of Matthew: "Behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, 'Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage.'"

The word "epiphany" comes from the Greek *epiphainen*, which means "to manifest," "appear," or "make known." The Feast of the Epiphany celebrates the revelation of Jesus, the Son of God, to the world. The magi, or kings, or seekers from the East, stand in for all the peoples of the earth, for Jesus comes not just for one group of people but for all.
